












Emergency Management of Paediatric Adrenal Crisis

Intramuscular (IM) hydrocortisone doses or initial IV dose

Age	IM hydrocortisone Dose	Indications for hydrocortisone
 <p>Less than 1 year</p>	 <p>25mg 0.25 mls</p>	 <p>Acutely unwell and unable to get IV access</p>  <p>Acutely unwell with diarrhoea and vomiting and unable to tolerate oral treatment</p>
 <p>1 - 5 years</p>	 <p>50mg 0.5 mls</p>	 <p>Reduced responsiveness or loss of consciousness.</p>
 <p>6 years & over</p>	 <p>100mg 1 ml</p>	 <p>Hypoglycaemic or new onset seizure in known or suspected adrenal insufficiency.</p>  <p>Fracture / significant burn</p>
